

EDD KEY

Edd Key's musical background runs from world ethnic to classical to rock to the southern sounds of his Kentucky roots.

In the mid-70s, he recorded in West Berlin for Germany's experimental Delta-Acustic label.

Returning to this country in 1977, he co-founded the Ohio rock group, SPITTIN' IMAGE, and recorded a number of his songs on the MCA label.

Moving to the northwest in 1985, Mr. Key turned his attention to music for the stage, establishing himself as an actor, musical director, and sound designer in Seattle's thriving theatre community. He performs regularly with Taproot Theatre and Book-It Repertory Theatre.

His popular collaborations with Eddie Levi Lee for Empty Space Theatre, include THE SALVATION OF IGGY SCROOGE, RODEO RADIO, and MANDRAGOLA UNCHAINED.

In 1998, he appeared at the Mark Taper Forum in Los Angeles in Peter Parnell's 8-hour stage adaptation of John Irving's *THE CIDER HOUSE RULES*. He appeared in his latest collaboration with Lee, *WUTHERING! HEIGHTS! THE! MUSICAL!*, at Actor's Theatre of Louisville as part of their Main Stage 2000 season. In September 2001, he helped create and appeared in DARKNESS LIFTING, a tribute to the 25th Anniversary of Habitat For Humanity. His most recent work was co-writing, with Myra Platt, the musical adaptation of Berkeley Breathed's book, RED RANGER CAME CALLING, for Book-It Repertory's 2012 season.

BIOGRAPHY

Edd Key discovered music one day during his tenth year when the elementary school music teacher brought four volunteers to the front of the class. The young Mr. Key, one of those volunteers, was given a tambourine and instructed along with his classmates as to how to play the musical exercise written on the chalkboard. In five short minutes she demonstrated to the class how notes indicate rhythm. She also set Edd on a path that would direct the rest of his life.

Those particular five minutes, coming somewhere randomly during the fourth year of regular weekly classroom instruction, continue to impress on Mr. Key the mercurial nature of music education. It is impossible to predict exactly where and how that magic moment might arrive when, suddenly, the "light bulb" illumines and abstract systems become clear.

Edd brings that sense of wonder and discovery to his own teaching and performance, along with a varied musical background ranging from folk to classical to avant garde music in many world cultures. As a trained multi-instrumentalist, he performs on and teaches most standard folk, band, and orchestral instruments. His workshops entertain while examining and unlocking the secrets of rhythm and sound. His teaching is customized to the individual, and has included private and institutional instruction in America, Europe, and Canada.

In Seattle, Mr. Key has established himself in the theatre arts through acting, music directing, and composing for a number of companies in the local theatre community, appearing regularly with Taproot Theatre and Book-It Repertory Theatre. His work with Seattle Public Theater's Touring Ensemble has involved the creation of plays, music, and educational activities designed to help audience members of all ages examine a variety of society's dilemmas. The Ensemble has taken Edd and his work to thousands of people throughout the Pacific Northwest.

His work as actor, composer and music director has been seen at the Empty Space Theatre in such hits as WUTHERING !HEIGHTS! THE! MUSICAL!, THE SALVATION OF IGGY SCROOGE, RODEO RADIO, and MANDRAGOL UNCHAINED

He was an ensemble member in the Seattle Repertory Theater's CIDER HOUSE RULES in 1996 and 1997, as well as the Los Angeles production at the Mark Taper Forum. In September 2001, he served as composer, music director, and actor with DARKNESS LIFTING, a World Communities Production celebrating the 25th Anniversary of Habitat For Humanity.

His energetic, friendly manner, his patient persistence, and his love of music and performance make him an ideal teacher and coach for group and individual instruction for all ages. Exploring the magical realms of music with Edd Key is invariably an enlightening and pleasant experience for all participants.
